



AFAS ACT SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY FELLOWSHIPS - 2011

Collaboration with France for ACT post graduate research students

AFAS ACT and the Embassy of France in Australia are offering post graduate science and technology research students residing or studying in the ACT a unique opportunity to undertake training or a collaborative study with a French University or research body in 2011. The grant of \$3,000 is a contribution to return airfares to France and living costs for the duration of the stay.

Applicants are requested to submit a completed application form, a brief outline of the project (1 page) and provide written evidence of:

- ✓ Project support from the Australian institution
- ✓ Cooperation and support for the project from the University/ research institution in France
- ✓ Benefits of the proposed project or training for the applicant's career and institutions involved

Applications are open to all post graduate science and technology research students from the Australian National University, the University of Canberra, the Catholic University, the Canberra Institute of Technology and the Australian Defence Force Academy. A working knowledge of French is desirable but not a requirement.

Applications for 2011 AFAS ACT Science and Technology Fellowships close on **27 August 2010.** Successful applicants will be notified by about mid October.
